

EMR AHA COURSES



Be prepared to save a life.

All courses require a skills check to receive a certification card.

1 **BLS** **Basic Life fir Healthcare Providers**

A 4-hour traditional instructor led course that covers one and two rescuer CPR for adults, children and infants. Proper use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and BVM is covered along with what to do if someone is choking.

2 **ACLS** **Advanced Cardiac Life Support**

ACLS builds on the foundation of basic life support (BLS) skills, emphasizing the importance of continues high-quality CPR. The course highlights high performance team dynamics and communication, systems of care. the course also includes the recognition of intervention in cardiopulmonary arrest, immediate post-cardiac arrest, and acute coronary syndromes (ACS).

3 **PALS** **Pediatric Advanced Life Support**

EMR offers the American Heart Association Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) to enhance your skills as a Pediatric Healthcare Provider. Our PALS course expands your knowledge and skills necessary to asses and treat critically ill infants and children. This is the Ideal course for babysitters, pediatric nurses, doctors, and physicians. Whether you choose a traditional course or PALS Heart Code online you receive a quality course in a comfortable environment. You will receive your AHA Certification upon successful completeion.

4 **HEART SAVER (HS) FIRST AID**

The Heart Saver First Aid course is a basic CPR class for the general public, not for medical professionals. It is a 2 hour course designed to prepare students to provide first aid in a variety of injuries and other emergency situations in a safe, timely, and effective manner.

5 **HEART SAVER CPR/AED**

The Heart Saver CPR/AED course is a basic CPR class for the general public, not for medical professionals. It is a 2 ½ - 3 hour course that covers one rescuer CPR for adults only. Students are trained to properly use an automated external defibrillator (AED) and what to do if someone is choking. There is an option for an additional charge to add child and infant.

6 **HEART SAVER FIRST AID/CPR/AED**

The Heart Saver First Aid/CPR/AED course is a basic CPR class for the general public, not for medical professionals. It is a 4 hour course designed to prepare students to provide first aid, CPR, how to use an AED, and what to do if someone is choking.

7 **HEART SAVER PEDIATRIC FA/CPR/AED**

The Heart Saver Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED course is a basic CPR class for daycare, babysitters, etc., not for medical professionals. It is a 4 ½ hour course to teach styudents how to respond to and manage illnesses and injuries in a child or an infant in the first few minutes until professional help arrives. students will be taught Child CPR, how to use an AED, and what to do if someone is choking.
